



Announcement of Phanomphrai Police Station
story Anti-Bribery Policy and No Gift Policy for Fiscal Year 2026

According to the Organic Act on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 128, paragraph one, prohibits any public official from receiving property or any other benefit which may be calculated as money from anyone other than property or benefit under the law, rule or regulation issued by virtue of Provisions of law, except for the receipt of property or any other benefit by virtue of ethics. According to the criteria and the number that the Board of Directors and the Code of Ethics of Police Officers B.E. 2564 (2021), Article 2(2) of honesty and honesty. Comply with legal obligations Formalities of the Royal Thai Police with transparency Do not exhibit behavior that implies wrongful exploitation. Responsible for human rights duties Be ready, be examined and held accountable, have a good conscience, take into account society, and Article 2(4) think of the common good rather than personal benefit. Public spirit, cooperation, cooperation and sacrifice in doing good for the common good and creating happiness for society. Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised) Define key reform activities Activity 4 Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and useless Goal 1 1.1. All government agencies shall be declared as agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of all kinds from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts of interest, bribes, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties, guidelines are prescribed. Anti-Bribery Policy and No Gift Policy from performing duties with details as follows:

Article 1: This Notice

"Supervisor" means a person who has the authority to direct, direct, monitor and inspect police officers under his subordinate officers.

"Bribe" means property or any other benefit given to a person to induce him or her to act. Act in any way in office, whether it is right or wrong, out of duty.

"Performance" means the act or performance of a public officer in a position appointed or assigned to perform a particular duty or to act on behalf of a particular duty. General and specifically as a police officer for which the authority or duties are prescribed by law or acted accordingly. The powers and duties specified by law shall be the authority of the police.

"Gifts, gifts, or any other benefits affecting the performance of duties" means money, property, or property. Other services or benefits that are valued and provided, including tips, received by public officials in addition to salaries, income, and benefits from the government in ordinary cases and affect decision-making. approval Authorize or otherwise perform duties in a manner that favors dishonestly the gift-giver, either in the past or at the time of receiving or in the future.

Article 2. Police officers at all levels shall conduct themselves as follows

(1) Do not ask, lead, not give or accept bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits from the performance of duties.

(2) Do not consent or knowingly allow family members to give or accept bribes, gifts, gifts or other benefits to related persons. In the performance of duties

(3) The performance of duties must adhere to law enforcement with fairness and the interests and image of the police. Must not commit any act that conflicts between personal and public interests, such as accepting gifts or other benefits that affect the performance of duties, using government resources for personal benefit, disclosing inside information, obstructing official hours for extra work, etc.

(4) Reduce the giving or receiving of property or other benefits in accordance with the rules and amounts prescribed by the NCC Office by using the method of expression by signing greeting cards, condolence cards, or using social media instead of giving items.

(5) Won't Not resistant. Not indifferent. Against the behavior of accepting bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits from the performance of duties, if found in violation of the act, the superintendent/station supervisor shall be notified as soon as possible.

Article 3 The supervisor shall have the authority and duty to supervise, monitor and inspect the police officers under him. Comply with this announcement. In case of any violation of this notice, the Superintendent/Station Superintendent shall be reported as soon as possible.

Article 4. Whoever finds an act in violation of this Notice Complaints/whistleblowers can be filed directly through the Superintendent of Changhan Police Station at Changhan Police Station or by phone number 043-259100-2.

Article 5: Complaints/Clues Personnel affiliated with the department committed such offences at Phanomprai Police Station will conduct an investigation. And if found guilty, the person who commits such act will be punished according to the law. Strictly comply with relevant rules and regulations, and continue to deliver matters according to the hierarchy of command.
